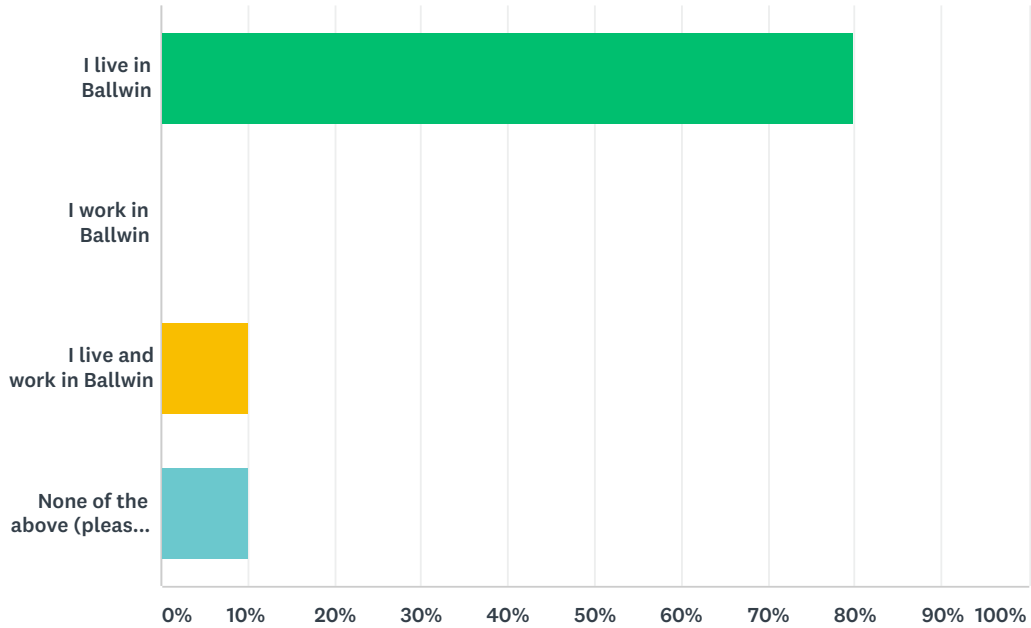


Q2 What best describes you?

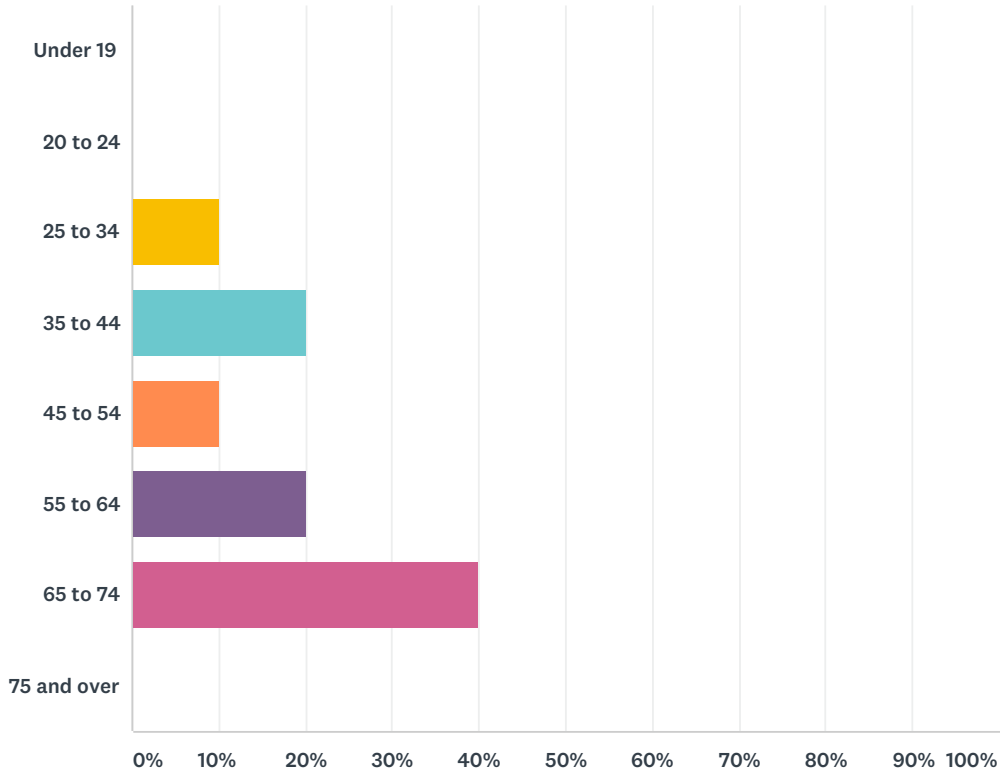

Q3 What is your age?

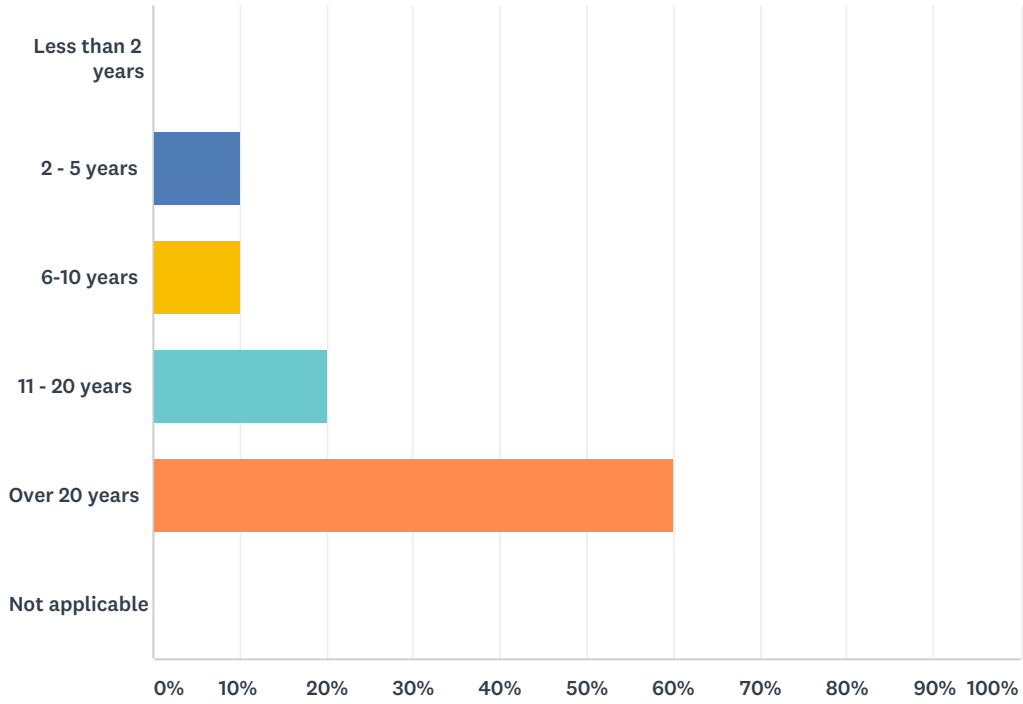

Q4 How long have you lived or worked in Ballwin?

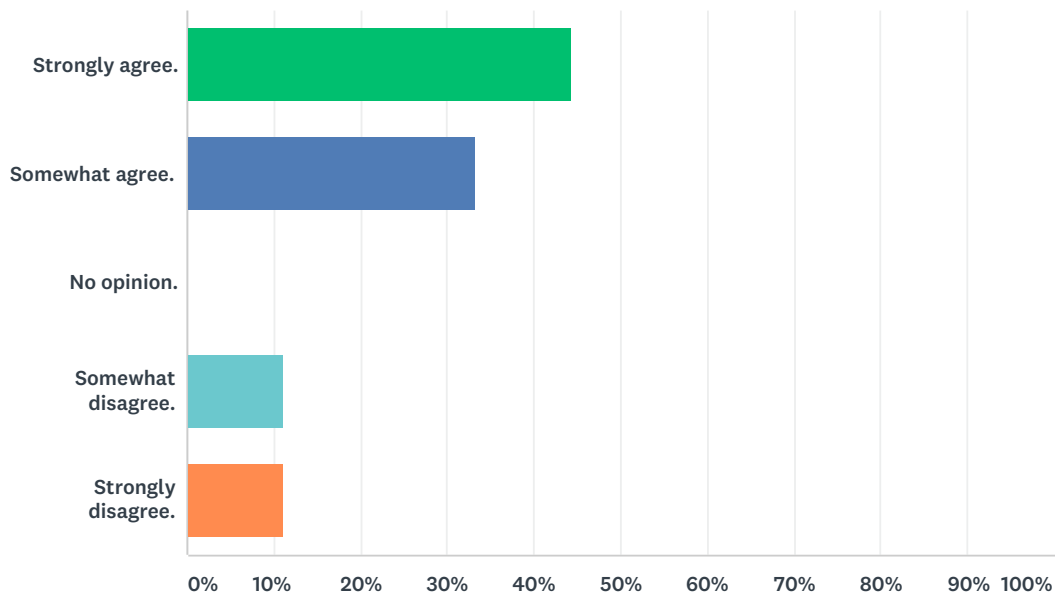

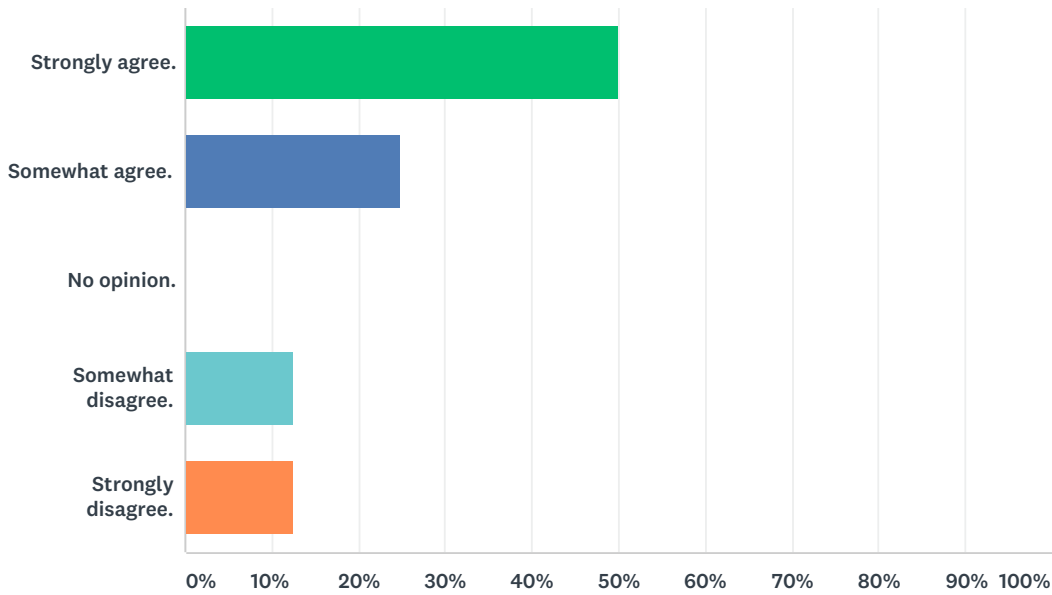

There is a great local nursery-Papillion- which grows native plants out in Wildwood, suited to our weather. It would be lovely to have more greenery that requires lower maintenance. Also, there are cultivated trees for tighter spaces, etc to go with all sorts of designs. It would be great to have a town center with negotiations with current businesses which might be destroyed by a total change. I'm glad you have the tree planting incentive. I didn't know about it. Love the updating sidewalks for continuity and easier access to walking. Wish people would not be allowed to route their sump pump/downspout to sidewalks as it makes a mess due to the soggy yard drainage there too. Would be a real step to sustainability for our future residents and family members to require more places to have recycling bins versus just trash everywhere. We can each do our part, but we need some ways to make it happen in public too to keep the planet healthier all over. Would love to have a voluntary composting program too to recycle food waste. While I'm on the subject, instead of making leaf removal seem like the best thing to do for our yards, can use as mulch or in the yard be considered/mentioned for good soil health and returning the nutrients to it? This would also reduce costs of hauling away. The plan is so comprehensive in data, thorough in so many ways, environmentally friendly, and with a good consideration of esthetics.
